- 2. DURATION OF THE PROJECT: 6 months, from the 24th of March to 23th of September 2020;**
- 3. BUDGET: 10.000.000 EURO -maximum amount of the grant;**

**7. GENERAL OBJECTIVE:** The action consists in the establishment of emergency medical countermeasures and/or personal protective equipment stock aimed at combatting serious cross-border threats to health, such as COVID-19, with the objective of reinforcing the emergency/disaster preparedness in EU. These stocks, managed by the applicant and constituted with ECHO's support, will be made available to all UCPM Partner States in case of serious cross-border threat to health due to the recent COVID-19 threat.

The project will comprise in the process of acquisition of an adequate number (the quantity of the most urgent medical items *-intensive care medical equipment, sets of personal protective equipment*) estimated according to the MS needs linked with COVID-19 threat.

The medical stocks will be stored in appropriate and adequate storage facilities, ready to be packed for distribution to the affected member and Participating State.

**8. PROJECT RESULTS:** Procurement of medical items with primary focus on **personal protective equipment** and **intensive care medical equipment**, in the shortest time possible, to be distributed according to the methodology and needs to the Member States affected by the COVID-19 threat. **The expected results is making available medical supplies available in the shortest time possible and their delivery to the affected member State according to the ERCC indication.**
