7. GENERAL OBJECTIVE:

- **Increased safety and protection of the population by improving training and maintaining the capacity of intervention of professional emergency services (including SMURD) in the border area.**

8. PROJECT RESULTS:

- ❖ **1 training facility (polygon) for specialised training of the personnel for interventions in emergency situations;**
- ❖ **7 landing platforms, of which 3 in Romania;**
- ❖ **2 new SMURD points in Republic of Moldova;**
- ❖ **2 Emergency Care Units (UPUs) in Republic of Moldova;**
- ❖ **1 set of common procedures for emergency situations;**
- ❖ **Increased operational capacity in Republic of Moldova by procurement of 14 SMURD vehicles.**
